## **Removing WiFi networks from Chromebooks**

### **Overview**

**Note:** You only need to do this if you have added a new wireless network


When you add a custom (home) WiFi connection to a chromebook it does not automatically delete itself until you manually remove it.

# Steps to removing a custom WiFi account


- 1. Log in with the default account
- 2. At the bottom right corner, click on the WiFi icon



3. Under the new window (just above the WiFI icon), select Settings



4. In the settings window under the **Network Settings** window, click **WiFi U of T.** 



5. You'll see a list of all nearby networks. To list all the remembered ones click Known networks,



6. . The list of remembered networks will pop up. Click on the triangle next to the network you have added and click Forget.
