- conduct preliminary research using the resources outlined in this guide, and
- locate at least one scholarly source (such as a book or journal article) that is relevant to your chosen subject.

Please be prepared to discuss your findings with the librarian during a research consultation. We recommend requesting an appointment as soon as you **begin to complete the work on your assignment**.
